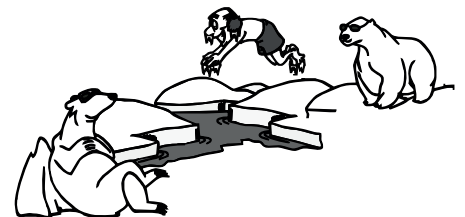




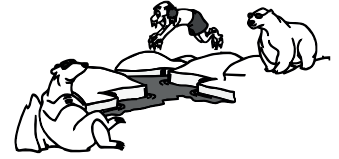
Polar Plunge Rules

1. *No Wetsuits!*
2. All 'Plungers' must be registered with the NB Lions prior to collecting ANY donations.
3. Individual 'Plungers' under 18 years of age must be accompanied by another 'Plunger' (into the water!!!) over 18 years of age and approved by parent or guardian.
4. 'Plungers';
 - No one under the age of thirteen (13) will be permitted to take the 'Plunge'.
 - Thirteen (13) - Eighteen (18) year olds must have written consent from parent or guardian prior to taking the 'plunge'.
5. Shoes must be worn when 'plunging' - wet socks, tennis shoes, work boots - whatever will match your 'plunging' outfit!
6. All 'plungers' must sign and date the waiver on the registration form indemnifying the New Baltimore Lions Club from any and all liabilities.
7. Registration forms must be submitted by January 10th to insure t-shirts and medallions.
8. FINAL REGISTRATION IS ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 29, 2017, FROM 11:00 A.M. UNTIL 1:00 P.M. We will not guarantee availability of t-shirts or medallions at final registration.
9. It is the sole responsibility of each individual 'Plunger' to read and understand the POLAR PLUNGE RULES.
10. It is the sole responsibility of each Plunging Teams Captain or designated contact person to insure that all team members have read and understand the POLAR PLUNGE RULES.
11. Those not adhering to the above Rules may be subject to disqualification from any and all awards.
